Buffet restaurants scare me. They are often laden with food that clogs your arteries. In addition, some I have visited don't maintain their food stations. Who wants banana pudding in the mashed potatoes? But I was told Jason Yang, owner of the Hong Kong Buffet in Parma, takes great care of his buffet, as well as his food preparation. The six steam stations, which are frequently refreshed and cleaned, offer several soups, a salad bar, steamed and sauteed vegetables, casseroles, a fried-food table and an array of desserts. I stuck mostly with the vegetable dishes. For fun, I grabbed a spoonful of the cheese and crab casserole, which has a richness similar to macaroni and cheese and melts in your mouth. The casserole owes its hint of sweetness to condensed milk. Buffet cost is \$6.49 for lunch and includes drink; \$9.49 for dinner, which includes drink. — **Greg Burnett**
